How to Load Megablasters

3 Inch Disc Version :-

Put disc 0 in drive A and type RUN DISC. The disc must be kept in the drive at all times, as this game loads in sections.

3.5 Inch Disc Version :-

Put disc 0 in drive B and type |B (| is produced by holding SHIFT and pressing the @ key). Then type RUN DISC. The disc must be kept in the drive at all times, as this game loads in sections.

Controls

For a one player game (see "Player Modes" opposite) you can start immediately with joystick, or you can choose to redefine the keys.

For a two player game one person may be on keys, by redefining them before play, and one on joystick. Alternatively, you can use a joystick splitter lead (one plug into the 6128 and two plugs of the joystick into the lead). Or a specially designed joystick can be used with a plug in the back for the extension of another joystick.

If you are playing Megablasters on a 6128 Plus, two joysticks/joypads can be used because of the double port.

To redefine keys (one or two sets) for two player mode, select "Two Players" on the options screen, then "Redefine Keys".

The Game

The idea of the game is to save your twin brothers. To do this, you must lay bombs, and blast your way to Cobron's castle. Simply drop a bomb and run away, out of firing distance. The bomb will then destroy everything within it's range. Behind some of the disposable blocks are bonuses and power-ups, see "Bonuses".

There are also wandering enemies that get in your way. You must destroy them all, before going on to the next level. As you progress in the game, the enemies will get harder to kill.

Some of the enemies that you will encounter are ; Teddies, Walking Bushes, Tanks, Clouds, Munchies, Snakes, Crabs, Wasps, Snails, Blobs, Choo-Choo Trains, Space Craft, Ghosts, Spooks, Bin Men, Cow-pat-laying-throbbers, Jesters, Dragons, Alien Space Craft, Snowmen, Santa-bombs, Devils, Fire-slugs, Icebergs, Ice Balls, Vulchers, Eyes, Water, Fire and Death (to name but a few).....and then there are the end of level guardians that Cobron has sent to try and stop you. You must also find the secret weapon, with out which you can not kill Cobron, therefore wiping out all Evil from your Land.

Player Modes

There are 3 different versions of Megablasters that you can play.

One Player :-

You take on the role of Bart. You must destroy all those who get in your way.

Two Player :-

One person plays Bart, another Bob. In unison you fight to rescue the twins. Same as one player, but with an extra pair of hands. Both people play on one screen.

Multi Player :-

For two to four players. On the options screen, this is accessed by the description "Battle Mode". Play against each other, to see who has the wit and cunning to outlast the others. All players play on one screen.

Bonuses

Through out the game, when you blow up a destructable obstacle, you will find bonuses and power ups. You get points for all of these, but some are points only.

Bonus

When you destroy some of the surrounding area, you will see that you can collect the letters B-O-N-U-S. One per level. At the end of a world, if you have all the letters, you will enter the bonus level, where lots of power ups and lives are available. You will then go on to meet the guardian, at your toughest.

Secret Levels

In the game, are some secret levels, but we cannot tell you about them, because they are secret, you will just have to find them yourselves.
