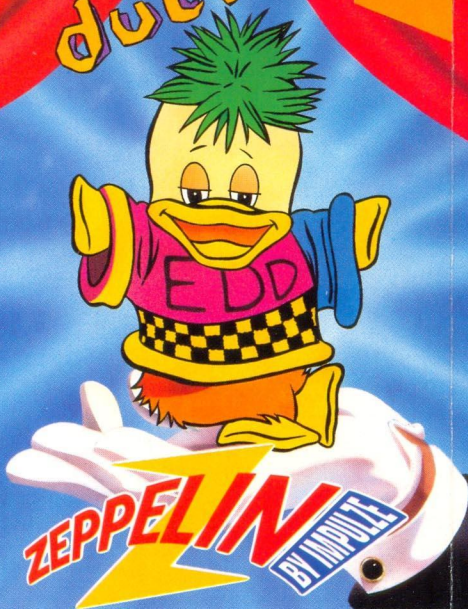

JOYSTICK CONTROLS



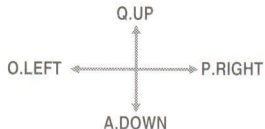
After the game has loaded, you can either begin "the shoot" straight away by pressing **0**, or the control methods can be set by pressing **1**.
